

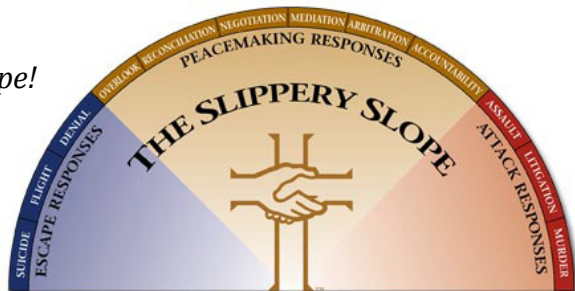
Forgiveness for Every Woman and Man Go and Be Reconciled
